

Dear colleagues,

I know that many of you have been waiting for more info concerning new rules which will govern ISOLDE access from July 1, when the hall gets upgraded to “RP controlled area” and we thank you for the patience. The involved CERN teams are close to finalising their aspects of the change and here is the latest info we have obtained:

Users and CERN staff who presently have access to ISOLDE (i.e. they have a permanent dosimeter and followed a 1-day RP course):

1. Follow an online ISOLDE-RP course (course close to finalising by CERN RP team; link will be available at the ISOLDE website).
2. Access ISOLDE: access recorded in your dosimeter.

Once your medical certificate expires, see next point.

CERN staff who don’t have a dosimeter:

1. Get your permanent dosimeter after passing a medical check at the CERN medical service.
2. Follow an online ISOLDE-RP course (course close to finalising by CERN RP team).
3. Follow a **1-DAY CERN class course on Radiation Protection - Controlled Area - CERN Employees and Associates**. Subscribe online via <https://hr-training.web.cern.ch/hr-training/> .
4. Ask for ISOHALL access in EDH (or ask a colleague to request it for you).
5. Access ISOLDE: access recorded in your dosimeter.

Users who don’t have a dosimeter:

1. Get your permanent dosimeter when presenting a signed “certificate attesting the suitability to work in CERN’s radiation areas” (being finalised this week; link to it will be available at the ISOLDE website).
2. Follow an online ISOLDE-RP course (course close to finalising by CERN RP team).
3. Follow a **2-h ISOLDE practical PR course** to start mid-July every Tuesday and Friday at 2pm (still in preparation by CERN RP team). Subscription will be done via email directly with the training center (email will be accessible via ISOLDE website).
4. Ask for ISOHALL access in EDH (or ask a colleague to request it for you).
5. Access ISOLDE: access recorded in your dosimeter.
