## TECHNICAL NEWS

### 1. SEPARATOR AREA :

- Description: The survey team results on FE11 were received. Misalignments of 3mm were found in one direction. Operators will determine with the beam if the hardware can cope with this misalignment.

### 2. MEDICIS:

- Description: A new glove box is being installed. Otherwise, things are pretty quiet there.

### 3. ISOLDE HALL :

- Description: Things are progressing reasonably well with the commissioning. The new logbooks were unstable at times. The new WISARD crane was connected on Monday. Outdated 3-phase outlets around the hall will be replaced soon.

- Description: CAEN modules/pre-amp and a new flange design are on the way. Timing tests will perform soon.
